BECOME A REGION OFFICER



ELIGIBILITY:

Region Officer Candidates must be:

- A current affiliated member of an affiliated chapter
- Enrolled in 6th grade or higher.
- Planning to attend the 2025 State Leadership Conference.

Region Officer Candidates must have:

- Successfully completed a Family and Consumer Science Course
- Participated in one of FCCLA's national programs
- At least an 80 unweighted GPA or higher

Region Officer Candidates cannot:

- Compete in Region or State STAR Events during their term in office.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Serve Georgia FCCLA and its members at the local, regional, state, and national level
- Attend and assist with their region events from start to finish
- Attend Georgia FCCLA's DISCOVER Training, December State Executive Council Meeting, and State Leadership Conference
- Develop and present workshops to chapter officers and members
- Visit local chapters
- Speak on stage in front of Georgia FCCLA members at conferences
- Represent Georgia FCCLA in various settings
- Maintain a professional image

ELECTION PROCESS:

Phase 1: Application - April 2025

- The candidate completes an application that includes:
 - The General Application
 - A resume highlighting FCCLA participation and accomplishments
 - A resume highlighting other involvement and accomplishments
 - Two letters of recommendation from an adviser and an administrator/ community leader
 - A transcript
 - Signature pages

Phase 2: Online Qualification Exam - April 2025

- The candidate will complete a qualifying exam on FCCLA/ FCS knowledge and trends.
- The test will be taken within a scheduled testing window.

Phase 3: Virtual Interviews - April 2025

- The candidates will complete a virtual interview with a region officer selection committee. The committee shall consist of at least three members and may include a:
 - Region Adviser
 - Alumni and Associates Member
 - Chapter Advisers
 - State Staff Member
 - State Executive Council Member
 - Graduating Region Officer

Phase 4: Region Officer Selection & Appointment to Office - April 2025

- The three highest-scoring candidates from each region who achieve an 80 or higher combined score will be elected as Region Officers.
- All candidates will be notified within one week after all interviews are conducted.
